What Americanism Means to Me

(Maplewood Institute Prize Essay)

GERALDINE SHEEHAN

There are certain words in the English language to which no particular definition can be ascribed as representing everyone's interpretation of them. There are words which, when heard by different people, present a distinct picture to each, evoked out of personal experience. There are words which have a special meaning

for each American. One such word is AMERICANISM.

What does Americanism mean to me? Well, when I think of Americanism, I think first of the Declaration of Independence, wherein lies the very birth of Americanism, and in which it was declared that "all men are created equal, having certain inalienable rights,—life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness." I think of the Constitution of the United States, that sturdy foundation upon which Americanism is based; that sacred trust created by my forefathers to make sure that for generations to come this nation would be a haven for a free people. My hardworking, self-sacrificing ancestors wanted to make sure that I would enjoy, as so few peoples today enjoy, the right to a trial by jury, the right to be secure in my home with no search except by court warrant, the right of free speech, the right and responsibility of a free press, the right to peaceable assembly and petition, the right of habeas corpus, and the right to worship God as my conscience dictates.

What does Americanism mean to me? Briefly, it means live and let live. It means a way of life, an experiment in democracy. It means the ruling voice of the people, greater than government. It means the spirit of freedom at work in a country where self-government reigns supreme. It means that, by trial and error, I can assist in making my laws and in amending them. It means that I have a voice in choosing my own leaders and in changing them frequently in the hope of finding better ones. By this system the door is opened to deceit and betrayal, to exploitation and robbery; nevertheless, under this imperfect system, the American people have become a greater, a happier, and a more prosperous people than any

other nation that ever lived under any system on this earth.

What does Americanism mean to me? It means the movement away from superiority and snobbery; away from the belief that one race is better than all others; away from a political order with militaristic and imperialistic tendencies; a movement toward freedom, culture, and originality. It means the spirit of a great people with a sense of humor that allows me to laugh at my leaders without jeopardizing my personal safety. I respect my fellowmen; I fear neither king nor

conqueror; I bend my knee to God, alone.

What does Americanism mean to me? It means the maximum independence of the individual and minimum of social control by organized society. Under our American way of life, domination by the individual or the organization is seldom attempted and never countenanced. The assumption of superiority by the privileged classes is not tolerated here in America. The American people still adhere to the teachings of the authors of the Declaration of Independence and the Constitution of the United States.

What does Americanism mean to me? When I hear the word Americanism, I think of Patrick Henry's immortal words, "Give me liberty, or give me death." Because our forefathers thought that freedom was worth more to them than life, they fought fiercely for it and earned it at a terrific cost. I believe that most of us,

Americanism, that they may be imparted to our children and our children's chil-

dren. Without liberty, life is a humdrum, monotonous, worthless routine.

What does Americanism mean to me? It means the merging of hundreds of nationalities, forming a national companionship, a brotherhood of men. It is not the fact that so many different kinds of people are working and living in America that makes it so remarkable, but the way they get along together, making little sacrifices for each other, trusting each other. Some of these have left the lands of their birth because of oppression and have come to this land with hopes for freedom and a chance to start life again. "Give me your tired, your poor,

Send these, the homeless, the tempest-tossed, to me.
I lift my lamp beside the golden door."

What does Americanism mean to me? It means a land which is rich, not in palaces, nor traditions, nor old family titles, but in opportunity, progressiveness, individualism. Here in America I can carve out my own career. My opportunity is limited only by what are conceived to be the rights of others. The standard of living I can maintain and the remuneration I can receive for services honestly

rendered are unequaled throughout the world.

What does Americanism mean to me? Its meaning is being made manifest to me every day, especially at this period of history when it is possible for me to contrast the way of life I enjoy with that of people of other countries. Some of us are born to Americanism; some adopt it. I was born to it, and I fear I have taken my country far too much for granted. I am trying to understand and appreciate the privileges with which I was presented by my democratic government. Having seen the unrest and oppression and aggression that are now let loose in the world, my indifferent attitude is challenged. With God's help, I will meet the challenge that each day brings.

What does Americanism mean to me? Well, it means so very much that I feel it must endure forever; and, in order that it may endure forever, belief in it is essential. A nation that firmly believes in its chosen way of life cannot be corrupted, cannot fall. Today, an element exists that is trying to corrupt this democracy in which I take so much pride. I must endeavor to do my part to discourage and overcome this tendency. Because of my love for Americanism, it is my earnest prayer that it may be the way of life for Americans for all time. No such magnificent inheritance has ever yet been received by any people on earth from any hand but

Heaven.

What does Americanism mean to me? Why, it means everything!



January 3, 1939—Back after Christmas vacation. Halls are littered with broken resolutions.


January 10, 1939—We're all learning to ski. Bandaged arms, legs, etc. appear on all sides.

May 12, 1941—Seven thousand and five hundred minutes left to school!


June 1, 1941—Only fifteen more days, and then we'll be on our own. Disgusting—isn't it?





in the combined, and the B team a good fifth.



Carsley of Pittsfield took second in both events and won the combined. Stepnowski finished fourth, with a good downhill run; Bill Eagan finished fifth; Wes Ashley, sixth; and Ed Bissaillon eighth.

Viewed as a whole the season for the P.H.S.Ski Team was a most satisfactory one.







Joe Tagliente was a reliable man on the football team as a tackle.




