


The hoopmen of P. H. S. finished their season in good standing this year. After being plagued by many serious hindrances and much sickness early in the season, they came back strongly to finish third in league play. John Genzabella, the relatively small senior as basketball players go, proved to be the big man for P. H. S.; he ended the regular season with 144 points, averaging 12 per game. Then came promising junior Chris Gilson with 110, Bobo Quadrozzi with 105, John Navin with 102, and speedy Dick Chapman with 93. The hoopsters proved by the way that they ended the season that if it were not for earlier misfortunes, Pittsfield High would have been a strong contender for the NBL title.

the morning of April 4, 1955!

Viewed through a classroom window the lofty dome, an emphatic symbol of Pittsfield High School, reminds us of the long, challenging path one must follow to reach the summit—Graduation

September, 1952

My first day at PHS, and was I scared! In the first place, I got lost and found myself in a "biology room" which turned out to be the freight elevator. A few of the upperclassmen gave me wild directions about the cafeteria; but I finally reached my destination—one hour and two lunch sections later. After lunch, everything went along smoothly. As I was passing from class to class, I was amazed by the size of the school and the huge number of students. What impressed me most was the size of the auditorium, and the thought of the first pep rally in it, when fifteen hundred PHS students will cheer the football team on to victory Saturday afternoon at Waheonah Park.

* * * * *


What pep! What spirit! I certainly was hoarse by the time I came out of the auditorium. The rally began with talks by Mr. Strout, Coach Fox, and the co-captains. Then the cheerleaders took over and made us scream our lungs out for dear old PHS. That echo cheer—is it ever the most!

At the first game of the season, our boys gave Greenfield a wonderful fight. Although I cheered, screamed, and jumped throughout the whole game today, I still remember how thoroughly frozen I was. After the game that cocoa at Liggett's, with the gang all around, certainly made me feel good.

December, 1952

Today was the day of the Christmas pageant. I usually associate a full auditorium with cheering and pep, but today I know that another feel-

ing, a much deeper one, can move the entire student body. The program itself was a Nativity tableau, followed by the singing of a Mystery by the glee clubs. When I left school and looked back at PHS as I walked up East Street, I could not help feeling very proud because I was one, just one, of a great number who had been moved by the beauty of Christmas, as it was presented by my classmates.

January, 1953

Departmental exams are all over. I'm sure I flunked the history test. I hate the thought of Monday, because that is when I learn my scores. I hate the thought of next Friday even more, because that is when report cards come out again.

February, 1953

After all my worrying, I didn't fare too badly on my report card. Now I'm spending all my time playing round-robin basketball, swimming at the Boys' Club, doing homework, and having fun at the "F" on Friday night. At school, everyone is looking forward to the spring activities.

May, 1953

Spring came quickly and left much too soon. Now, in late May, the school year is waning; and although there is still plenty of excitement about

the baseball games and much of the usual dread about departmentals, a sort of wistfulness seems to be pervading the school. Every morning on the mall the seniors are busy practicing, and those of us in "Y" groups are equally as busy planning farewell parties and outings at the Canoe Club and Camp Merrill.

June, 1953

The first year at PHS is over; from now on I am a junior—an upperclassman. Come next September I'll feel very blasé about my first day as a junior, but as of now I'm not over self-confident about the added responsibilities which will accompany the new rank. Now that school is out and I am just beginning to relax after a year of hectic sophomore activities, I feel that I have completed the most challenging, perhaps the most difficult part of the path which I must follow to reach the goal of graduation.

October, 1953

There has been so much excitement during these two months! Every day has been filled with activities for *The Student's Pen*, Tri-Hi-Y, and the hockey team. Only one event has darkened the surface so far, and that was the "famous" rally before the Pittsfield-St. Joe game. I'm try-

ing to forget that, for it was too sad a story for everyone concerned.

December, 1953

It's now junior election time, and everything has reached a feverish pitch. Next week the candidates will give speeches before the entire class; this assembly will be the deciding factor before voting time. We're going to use city voting machines, and Mr. Herrick has already chosen an election committee.

March, 1954

Plans are now being completed for the annual Western Massachusetts Music Festival, which will be held here on May 13th. Now the seniors are also rehearsing their class play; and

June, 1954

The seniors are as proud and carefree as can be, now that their studies are completed and graduation is so close. We juniors have become proud also, because today many of us received our class rings, which make us true upperclassmen.

Everyone is enthusiastic about this idea, as they are enthusiastic about the great activities of the student booster committee, which delegates one of its members to speak at every pep rally. There seems to be somewhat of a problem with the male cheering section, but I'm sure that the student booster committee will devise some plan or stunt to make that section cooperate fully.

November, 1954

One of the many innovations this year has been the new *Student's Pen*, which everyone predicts will win first place again at the Columbia Scholastic Press Association Convention in March. Another innovation this year is the hilarious boys' cheering squad, captained by Don Terpak, which has apparently cured the indifference in the boys' cheering section. Although the football team has not been faring too well, everyone is saying that we will have a great basketball squad.

December, 1954

The senior class council has elected all the various committees, and the senior class has elected Stephanie Wojtkowski our representative to Good Government Day at the State House in March.

March, 1955

The play was a big hit, and everyone connected with it did a tremendous job. There were fabulous parties afterwards, and, all in all, it certainly was a memorable evening for everyone . . . The months are literally flying by now.

June, 1955

Class Day was both impressive and entertaining, as the various awards and scholarships were announced and the different hilarious acts were presented; and, of course, the planting of the tree of the Class of 1955, and the oration, were moving ceremonies for not only the seniors but for the entire student body. We have begun practicing for our own graduation—the culmination of three years of fun, work, and ceaseless activity—which will take place on June 19. Senior prom and banquet will be on the evening of June 16 and all the girls look wistful and very, very happy. Patch tests and final departmentals; Tri-Hi-Y, Hi-Y outings; afternoons of swimming and laughter—all of these are bringing our three years at PHS to a close.

Graduation. The most important event not only in my own high school days, but in those of every person I know. It was a sad and yet auspicious moment as I walked up to receive my diploma, for I felt that although I had dreamed and hoped for this day for three long, sometimes difficult years, I could not quite realize this formal closing of my experiences at PHS. Graduation was the consummation of my activities as a PHS student; it marked the end of a hard climb up the trail to the summit, where one could nostalgically view the path below and gaze hopefully into the horizon beyond.
