



In February the long and short of things were duly found out from the measurements taken by the Cap and Gown Committee. Suddenly we all realized that Commencement activities were just a few short months away.

which lasted to the wee hours of the morning. The gym was beautifully decorated and couples—the girls in dreamy gowns and boys in the snart white dinner jackets—danced to the romantic strains of the orchestra.

In a fever of rehearsing, graduation drew ever nearer. At last Sunday, June 14, arrived, and for once we all sat quietly and subdued in rows before our heloved school, our faces grave above the purple and white robes as we awaited our turn to receive the diplomas from the mayor.

Graduation is over and the class of '59 has become a part of history. As we look back with pleasant memories, and look forward with hope, faith, and love in our hearts, we say farewell to Pittsfield High School.
