
DEDICATION

Sparked all year both offensively and defensively by inspiring work from the line and flashing brilliance in the backfield, there was little this squad could not do. A fitting testimony to this is that no less than thirteen P.H.S. boys were named to the Eagle's All-Berkshire team.


In addition to the above distinctions, the squad had the league's leading scorer in Ray Woitkowski, who appeared on just about every "all" team in Western Massachusetts. The fine season can not be traced to one boy, however, as this year can be most fittingly called a superb team effort. For instance, the boys' drum-tight pass defense did not permit a single touchdown all year, while their spirited line at one point in the season limited three successive opponents to a total of twenty-eight yards rushing. Throughout the season this fine P.H.S. unit outscored its rivals by a whopping 124 points! Needless to say, statistics such as these reflect the work of the coaches—and P.H.S. is fortunate in having five of the league's best. Many were the hours they spent in the lesser known tasks of evaluating game movies and scouting, in addition to working actively with the boys. Their tireless efforts showed to good advantage at each game and were, in many cases, the difference between victory and

In short, the squad was a tribute to hard work, team spirit, determination, and wise coaching. Its feats will surely be long-remembered.


