Pittsfield High School's undefeated football season in the fall of 1960 led many partisans to claim all-time greatness for the team that put together the record. This 1960 unit swept to eight consecutive victories, the first perfect record for a modern P. H. S. team.

In an exciting season Pittsfield trailed only once; that occurred in the second game against Northampton. After falling behind 7-0 in the third period, Coach Nick Morris' outfit ignited for three touchdowns in the last eleven minutes to gain an 18-7 win. Other satisfying wins were the 38-0 conquest of Adams and the 46-12 victory over Drury High, the oldest rival.

St. Joseph's offered stubborn resistance in the season finale, but Pittsfield High triumphed 18-7 to clinch the Western Massachusetts Class A Conference title and the Berkshire County championship, both for the second successive year.

Pittsfield started the season with nine veterans. Injuries were numerous, but P. H. S. had such depth that it was not seriously weakened even by the loss of some experienced players.

With new activities, new work to be done,


