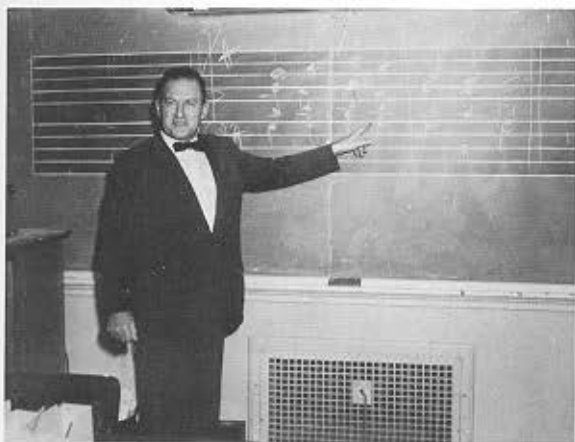

DEDICATION

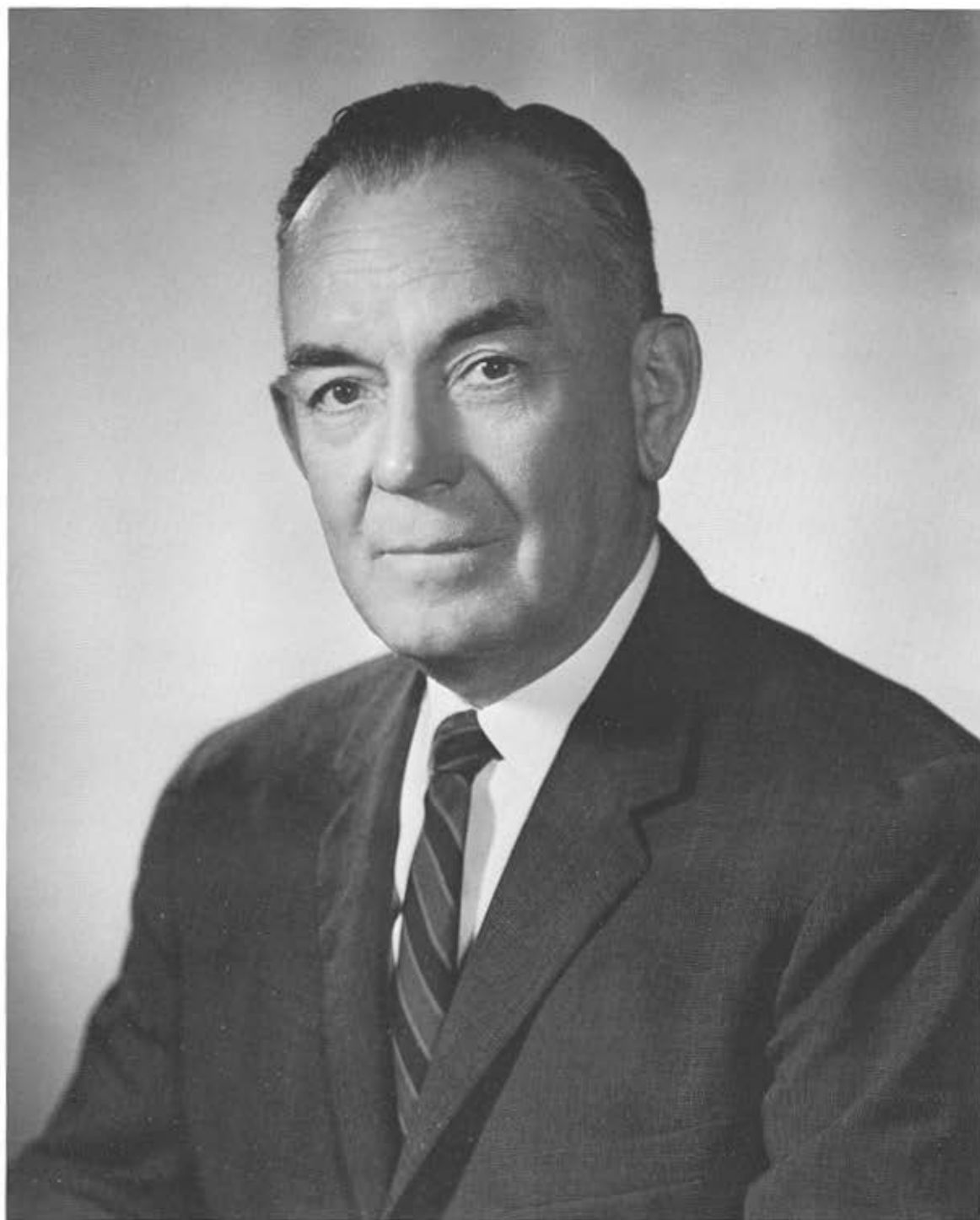



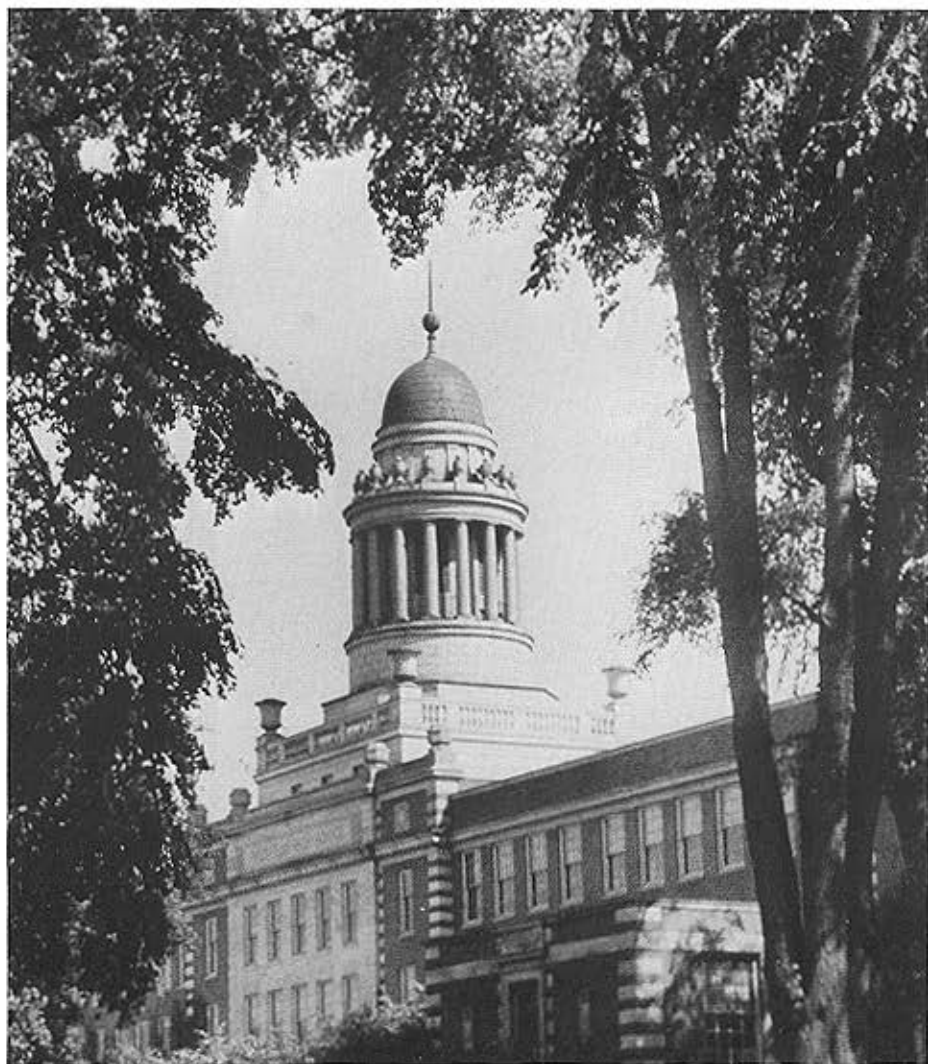
We are proud to have been educated under his capable leadership, and we wish him every happiness in the future.

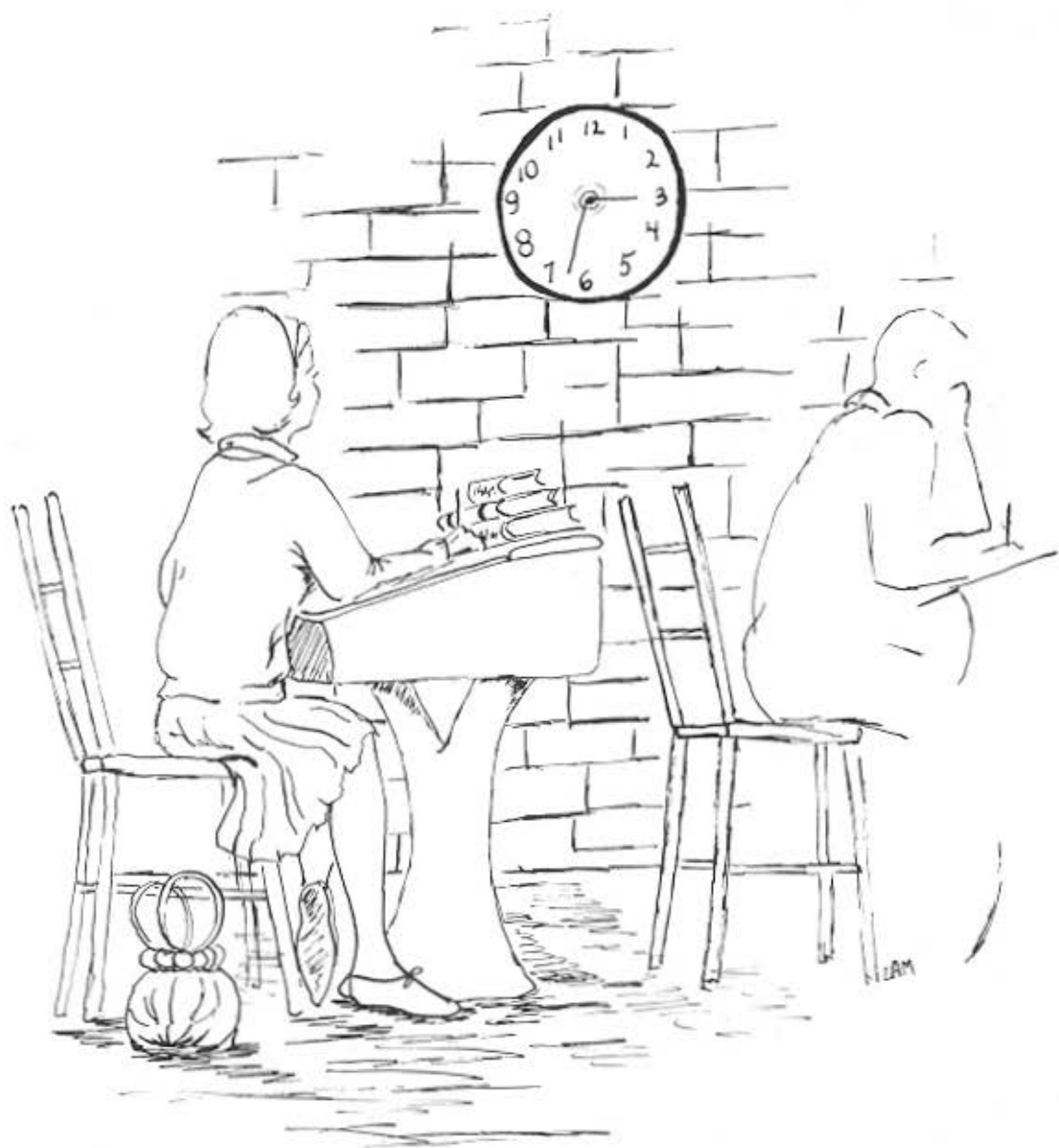

The 1961 Pittsfield High School football team, for the third straight year, won the Western Massachusetts Class A, Berkshire County, and City Championship titles with a 7-0-1 record. In these three years the team has compiled an outstanding 22-0-2 record, regaining for our school the gridiron supremacy in Western Massachusetts.

Coach Joe Gleason, in his first year as head coach at Pittsfield High School, molded this championship team around a sturdy nucleus of veteran seniors, including linemen, Jim Collins, Steve Ciepela, and John Farrell and hard running backfield men, Gary Sitcer, and Ray Woitkowski. Evidence of Coach Gleason's success in both the offensive and defensive phases

of the game is that the team scored 222 points and allowed only 38 points to its opponents.

The season was highlighted by Pittsfield's successful debut in class A.A. football in which they beat West Springfield High 24-12 in an exhibition contest. Although this game had no influence on our league record, it boosted the team's morale and the school's prestige.

Six P.H.S. players earned starting berths on the All-Berkshire team: Steve Ciepela, Jim Collins, Gary Sitcer, Fran Reardon, Bob Bard, and Ray Woitkowski with Woitkowski capturing high scoring honors in Western Massachusetts with 110 points.
